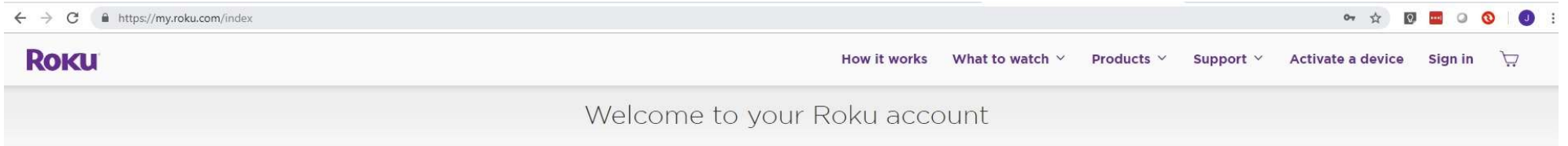




How to Activate Your GCET

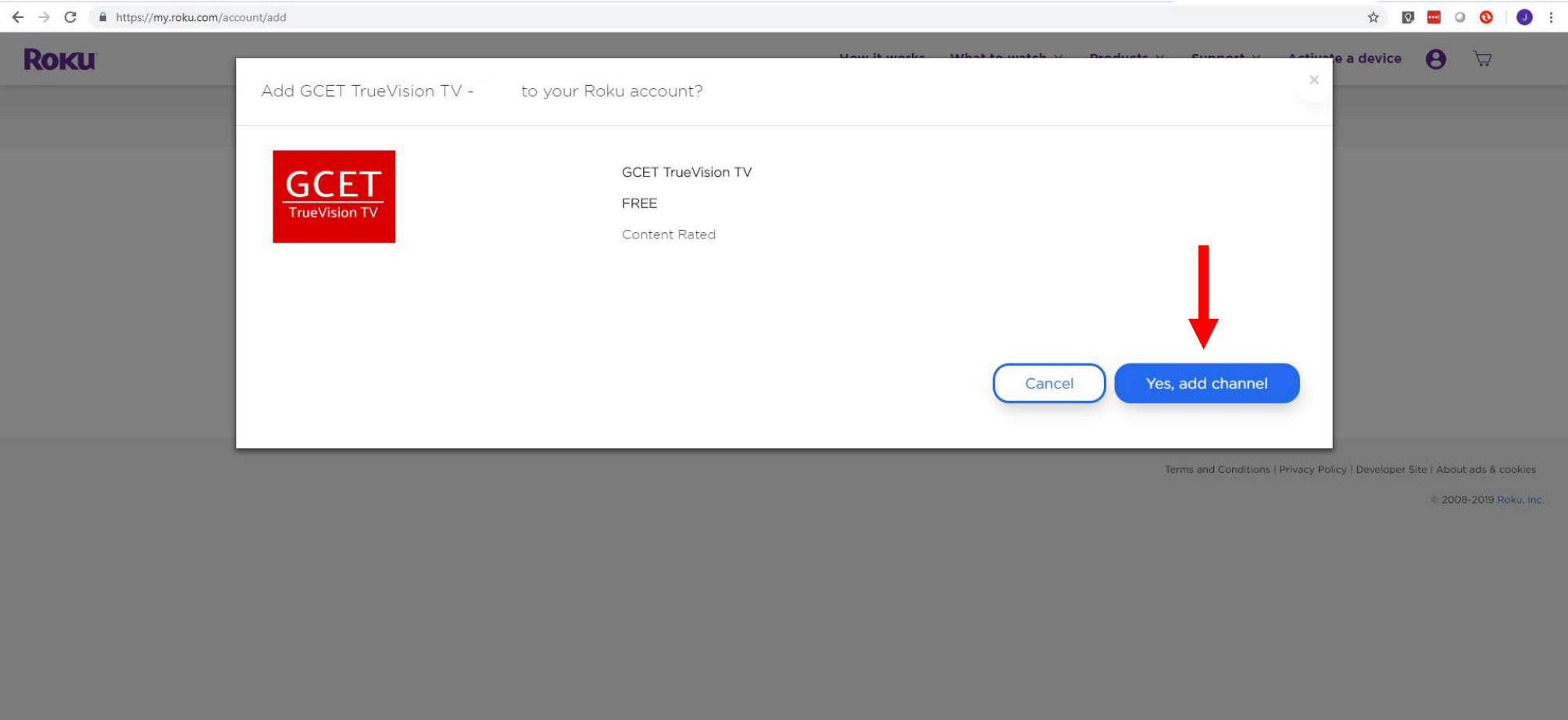

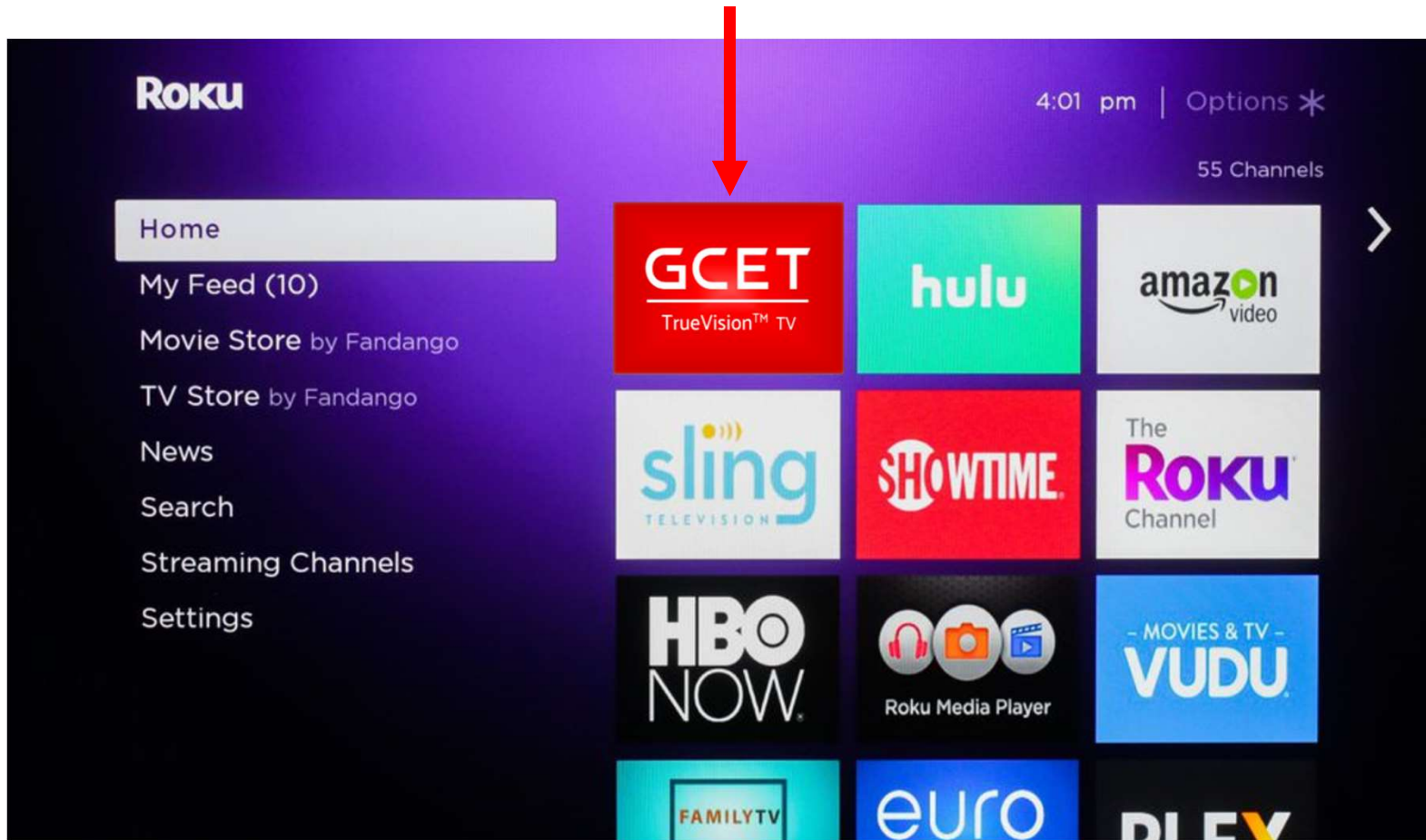
If you see this warning, click "OK"

Go to your Roku Home screen, click on GCET TrueVision TV. You may need to scroll to find your channel.



If your new GCET TrueVision TV Channel does not immediately appear on your home screen, you may need to manually update your Roku. Follow the instructions below.

Manually checking for updates

Follow the instructions below to manually check for software and channel updates.

1. Press the **Home** button  on your Roku remote.
2. Scroll up or down and select **Settings**.
3. Select **System**.
4. Select **System update**.

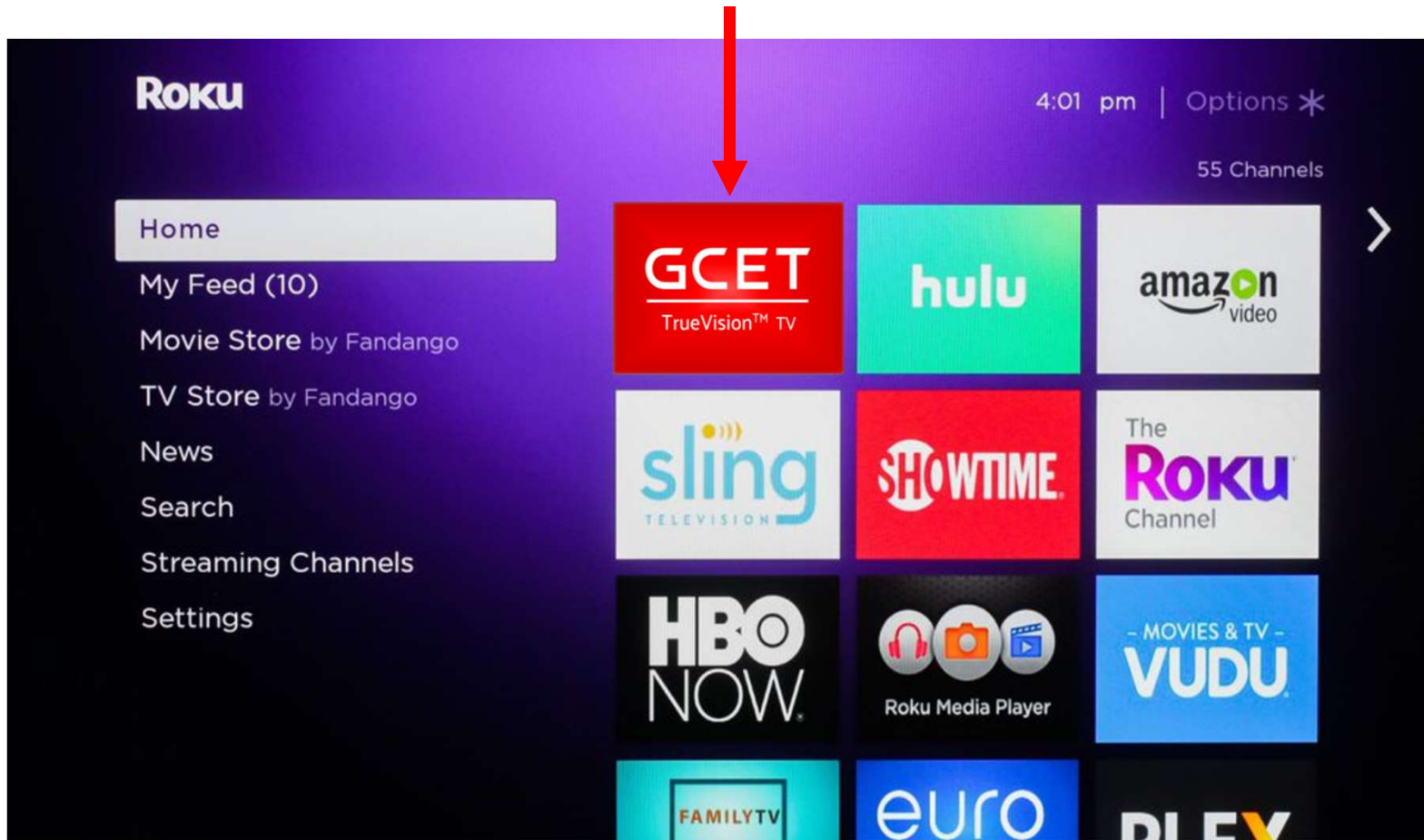
Note: The System update screen displays the current software and build version, along with the date and time of the latest update.

5. Select **Check Now** to manually check for updates.

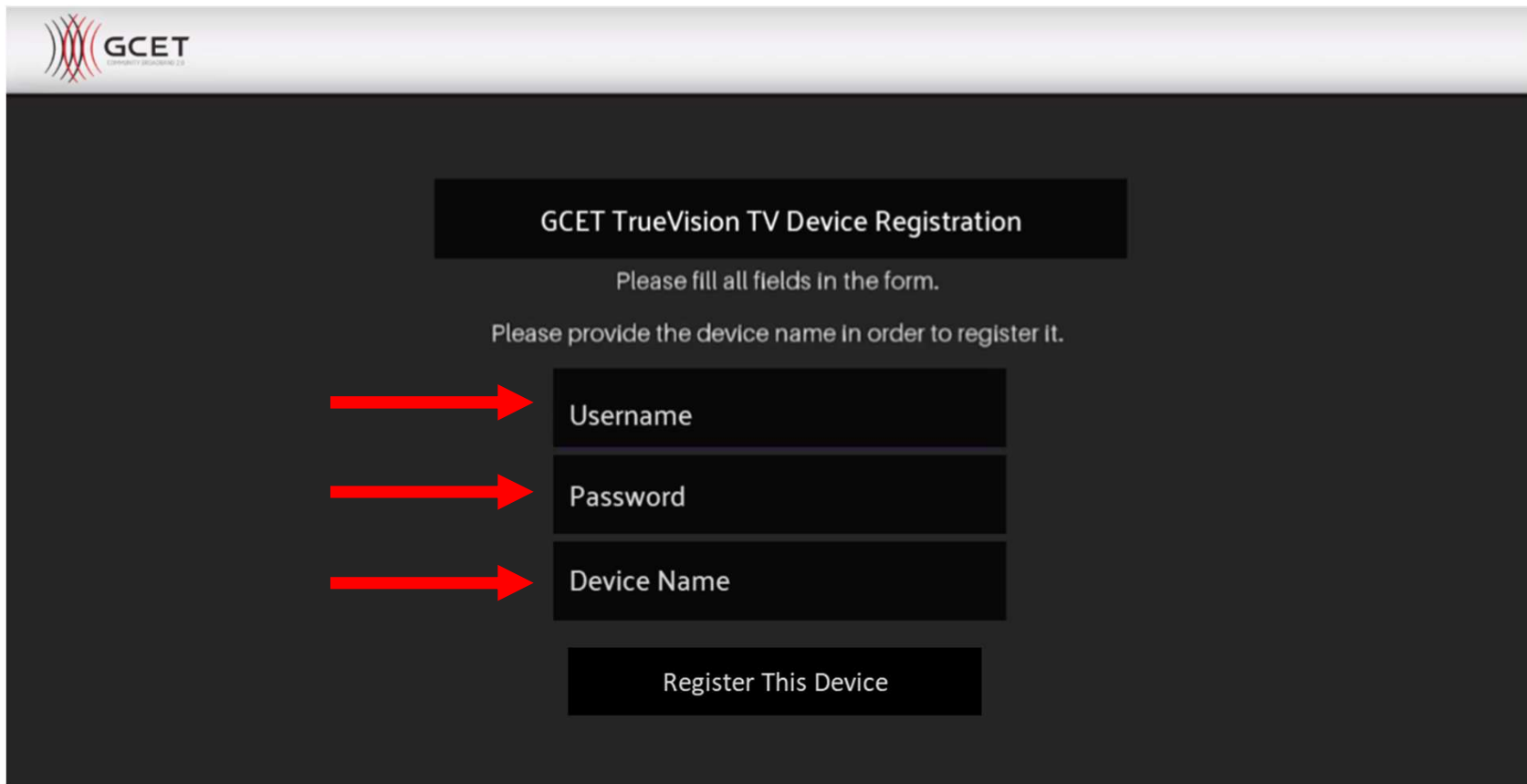
If there is new software available or there are updates for your channels, then your Roku device will download and install them automatically and once completed, your Roku device will reboot.

Your GCET TV Channel will now appear on your home screen.

When you have found your GCET TrueVison TV Channel – Click it.



On the GCET TrueVision Registration Screen, enter your GCET provided Username and Password (both are numbers – Please write them down!) and enter your preferred Device Name – for example: Living Room TV. Then Click Register This Device
